[REDACTED], a Roger Butt, owned and operated a fishery plantation in Carbonear as early as 1676. He also owned property in Crocker's Cove, N. of Carbonear, (1675).

(1770) A Roger Butt bought a plantation in Freshwater, N.E. of Carbonear.

(1804) Joseph (with 3 married sisters) owned plantation in Carbonear, willed them by father in 1783.

(1747) John Butt bought plantation in Clown's Cove from John Pike for £ 20-.

(1788) Joseph Butt bought fishing room in mosquito, N. of Carbonear, for his grand son.

(1755) John Butt, born in Newfoundland, later became sailor in Newfoundland trade and resided in Canford, England.

(1804) Joseph Butt owned plantation in Crocker's Cove, a gift from his father in 1767. In family since 1743.

(1750) William had plantation in Broad Cove, N.E. of Carbonear. Also cleared a second plot there in 1776.

(1775) A William Butt had a plantation in Carbonear.

(1823) William, Jr., had plantation in Western Bay, N.E. of Carbonear.

(1806) A William Butt owned plantation in Bradley's Cove, N.E. of Carbonear. Possessed it since 1784-85.

(1802) John Butt cleared plantation in Northern Cove, N.E. of Carbonear.

(1784) Thomas Butt had land in Carbonear. (1790) Thomas acquired a plantation in Blackhead, a gift from his mother-in-law.

(1815) A Martha Butt, Harbor Grace, owned rental property at Crocker's Cove.

(1793) Henry Butt, a Carbonear planter.

(1815) Also, a Henry Butt at Clown's Cove, N.E. of Carbonear.

(1803) A Charles Butt at Clown's Cove.

(1819) Martin Butt at Freshwater, N.E. of Carbonear.

(1818) Moses Butt at Broad Cove.

(1827) James Butt, planter at Spaniard's Bay, near Harbor Grace.

(1820) Aaron Butt at Freshwater.

(1829) A James Butt at Bonavista, Bonavista Bay.

(1828) Solomon Butt at Spaniard's Bay. A Solomon Butt spent most of his adult life at St. George's Bay on the west coast of Newfoundland. He is possibly the same Solomon formerly of Spaniard's Bay.

(1779-1864) An isolated George Butt at Harbor Buffett, Southern Shore, died in Grand Bank in 1864.

Some of the Butts were descendants of Roger Butt, early plantation owner in Carbonear (1676). Others came later during the 18th century. Most were concentrated on the westside of Conception Bay, in Carbonear, and communities North of there. The difficulty with regard to researching the lives of individual Butts rests not with the variety of their christian names, but with the tendency of Butt families in the 1750-1830 period to make multiple use of the same christian names, John, Joseph, William, and George for example. This, and the close proximity of Butt settlement patterns - overlapping in some cases - would require considerable historical detective work of a time consuming nature.
