Thursday 28th Mr Smiths Boat returned about 10 o'clock ^{last} at 8 P.M.
 with the Priest. This a squally day in the afternoon
 Snowed nothing particular occurred. Wind S.W.

Friday
 March 1st This day Mr Smiths people carried up the Priest. I
 had a thought of going up myself but delay^d so
 long that I ~~could~~ stay too long untill I let them
 go without issue. Mr Senior carried my letters to
 Odariv. nothing particular occurred. Just Received a letter
 from Odariv with some papers from Mr Coderoy & Mr
 Blah the Lord they are all well a fine day Wind N

Saturday 2nd This a fine day nothing particular occurred since
 I lost my time to Burin yesterday by wind hath
 been weather unhappy. the wind to day E.S.E.

Sunday 3rd This another blessed Sabbath and so Service was^t cut
 from every means of Grace. I was finding myself that I
 would be at Burin this day but I reflected to im-
 prove to post my baggage. I saw the Steamer go
 Note by this afternoon for Burin. Mr Smiths came back
 this Evening heard that George was to the Boat,
 I want to see them this coming week this a very
 fine moderate day Wind N.W.

7 July

Came in here in this lonely spot I am rather uneasy in
reference to my wife her legs and feet continue to swell
so much I fear it will end in some serious consequence but
I trust the Lord will still stand by me as he hath ever
been to me praise his Holy Name, June 24th Miss W

Saturday 23rd This day was very boisterous with the wind very
high Rec^d a letter from my (Sister Mary Hamner
written) the 11th instant nothing particular. Bless the
Lord that all my Children are well & Lord keep
them safe and may the time soon come when
I shall see them all again in the flesh Amen Miss
W

Sunday 24th This another blessed Holy Sabbath a profitable day
no doubt to hundreds of precious souls that
have had the happiness of sitting under the
droppings of the Sanctuary while we dead and
barren souls here are still deprived of those
blessings O Lord we do take for us and bring
us to a place where we shall again enjoy
sweet Communion with thy people & answer
Mary Ann Bealy & Henry Collins was here this
afternoon and was paid for Hymn Books a
Dirty day Snow fell and rain wind S. S. W. S. E

Monday 25th This a very rough day the rougher the winter
with snow and freeze very hard. Wind almost a
Gale to W. S. W.
