The Last Will and Testament of Walter Irwin
of St. Johns Newfoundland

In the name of God Amen
I Walter Irwin being sane in body, but of a sound
mind and understanding, do hereby give and bequeath,
my soul to God who gave it, and my body to the
earth from whence it came.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son William,
and to my present Wife Mary the whole of my earthly
property, Houses lands and Tenements, as well as all
Goods and Chattels of which I am possessed, or monies that
may be due to me, after paying off my lawful debts, to be
by them equally enjoyed and possessed for their own benefit,
and the support of my other three children until
they are of age, and able to support themselves, which my
Executors are desired and authorized to see carried into effect.

I do hereby appoint and ordain Mr. John Propper
and Mr. Wm. Armstrong Senr. to be my true and lawful
executors and authorize them according to Law to see
that my last will and testament carried into force.

N.B. It is to be understood that my son William
is to be considered the true and lawful Heir to the
farm of lands held by lease from Government.
