


Diagram of Land Survey at Little Catalina, formerly

for and in consideration of the sum of one
Hundred Pounds money there bargained
and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell unto Stephen jeans of Catalinae
~~and his heirs for ever all the rest~~ ^{Stephen} Fishing
Room and Premises situate Belonging to
me consisting of dwelling House, out houses, Stage
Plots, Garden and Grounds appertaining to
the said premises situate in Little Catalinae
bounded on the East by Water on the South
by House, Sted, Premises on the West by Water
and on the North by the Water Premises

To the said Fishing Room and Premises in any
way Belonging To Hold the same to the said
Stephen jeans His Heirs or assigns for ever
In Witness whereof I the said
John Day have hereunto my hand and
Seal Subscribed and set at Catalinae, In the
Island of Newfoundland this twentieth Day
of November in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand
Eight Hundred and Eight Two.
