1787 25 oct col recs elias appted one of three JPs at bonavista he keeper of rolls

LANGDON

1788 30 jul col recs elias JP at Bonavista - complaints of his behaviour during the winter. he is (we are informed) about to leave the district.

1788 8 aug col recs elias JP -0 wm brown JP makes serious accusation agst him/ capt Pakenham to investagite if true he is to be dismissed if not true your are to dīsmissee WM BROWN

LANGDON

1788 30 aug col recs Gov Ellkiot fears that bonavista inhabs with assistance of the agents of the two principal houses at trinity are determined to drive him out of that district

LANGDON

1788 19 sep col recs elias. capt pakenham finds charges against him fully justified " I have scarsely met with a character so infamous and as some of his servants who did not get paid applied to me for relief ...mr langdon is TOTALLY INSOLVENT - svts have no prospect of wages 9 or 10 of them applied to me

1792 apr - det muster roll of elias age 19 churston/widdecombe on
sick to witness of disintention (ex friends maloney bkr)
