- 2. JOHN_Planter of Petty Harbour Newfoundland*no wife in nfld) 1708.
- John son of Thomas and Jane born Tormoham Devonshire 1635 1735.
- 4. JOHN "Bye Boat keeper" of Devonshire, in nfld fl c 1742-1748
- 5. JOHN of Southampton England commander of a vessel in the Mediterranean Trade 1749-1759.
- 6. JOHN residing in Torbay Newfoundland married thomasine Martin(*widow) 1775 in 1776 had a son John.

LOWE SAMUEL

Born Kingsteignton devonshire 1730, son of thomas and Mary.

LOW THOMAS

- 1. Thomas and Jane of Tormoham had a son Thos baptised 1730.
- Thomas son of Richard and Florence baptised Kingstiegnton devonshire 1733
- 3. this is almost certainly the same as (2) above. importing timber into Teignmouth(devonshire 1766).

low william

- 1. William of South Devon, a Bye Boat keeper in Newfoundland fl 1740s.
- 2. William(of Scotland . in 1821 Commander of the RISING SUN 94 tons registered in Newfoundland and owned by Andrew Lowe mariner.

LOW X JAMES

- 1. JAMES Buried in St Johns Newfouindland July 1783
- 2. JAMES married mary underhay in St Johns 1786
- 3. JAMES son of george and jane buried(infant) in Churston DEVONSHIRE 1805
- 4. JAMES in partnership with wm Metford in Carbonear. in 1834 his partner died. Sums inolved in legal case were quite large.

LOW ANDREW

- 1. ANDREW died Churston Devon in 1814 aged 94.
- ANDREW OF GREENOCK MASTER MARINER
 - 1814 Commander the GARLAND 193 tons owned James Macbraire merchant 1815-16 commander of the sT LAWRENCE ship 210 tons owned wm Henderson of Falkirk Merchant. and 1817
 - 1818-19 commander the WARNER brig 161 tons own Phlip Warner of Greenock.
 - 1819-21 Commander of the MARQUIS OF WELLINGTON cutter 270 tons owned Andrew Love of Greenock./
 - 1821 in November bought the RISING SUN(see wm above) from John Broom of St Johns.

LOWE Philip

1. Born in Tormoham Devonshire in 1664 son of George and Elizabeth

LOW RICHARD

1. Born in Kingsteignton Devonshire 1730 son of Richard and Florence.

LOWE ROBERT

1. Commander of the STAG of Greenock at St Johns in 1811.
