Whereas there was this Day read at the Board's Report from the Right Honourable the Lord of Committee⁽²⁾ of Council for hearing Appeals from the Plantations &c dated the 2nd of this instant in the Words following Viz:

" mond Esq^r; Mr. Clement Guillaume, John " Dumaresq Esq^r one of the Executors of the " Will of James Pipon Esq^r deceased, John " Maret, and Edward Le Feuvre Attorney to " George Le Feuvre Setting forth, That the Ap- "pellant James Renon, Agent and part Owner of " Newfoundland Fishery; That John Le Brun " the Respondent on the 16th Day of October " 1803, being at the Bay of Gaspee in America " engaged himself, to M^r George Le Feuvre the " Master of the said Brig of which the Appellant " James Renon was agent and part owner, to " serve in the Capacity of Mate on board the said " Brig from the time of its sailing from the said " Bay of Gaspee until its arrival at Jersey at the " rate of Seventy Livres French Currency per " month, the said Respondent being desirous of " returning as soon as possible to his Country " was satisfied with such moderate Wages; That " some Days after the said Brig sailed for Jersey, " and was taken, on the 10th of November follow- " ing by the French Privateer, " Le Brave", " upon which occasion George Le Feuvre the " Master of the "Duke of Argyle" entered into " an Agreement with the Captain of the said " Privateer to ransom the said Brig for the sum " of Six thousand livres or £250 Sterling for " which sum the said George Le Feuvre drew a " Bill of Exchange on his Owners payable to the
