mitted the humble Petition and Appeal of “ James Remon Esq:; James Lempriere Ham- “ mond Esq:; Mr Clement Guillaume, John “ Dumaresq Esq: one of the Executors of the “ Will of James Pipon Esq: deceased, John “ Maret, and Edward Le Feuvre Attorney to “ George Le Feuvre Setting forth, That the Ap- “ pellant James Remon, Agent and part Owner of “ the Brig called the “ Duke of Argyll ” in the “ Year 1803 employed the said Vessel in the “ Newfoundland Fishery; That John Le Brun “ the Respondent on the 16th Day of October “ 1803, being at the Bay of Gaspée in America “ engaged himself, to Mr George Le Feuvre the “ Master of the said Brig of which the Appellant “ James Remon was agent and part owner, to “ serve in the Capacity of Mate on board the said “ Brig from the time of its sailing from the said “ Bay of Gaspée until its arrival at Jersey at the “ rate of Seventy Livres French Currency per “ month, the said Respondent being desirous of “ returning as soon as possible to his Country “ was satisfied with such moderate Wages; That “ some Days after the said Brig sailed for Jersey, “ and was taken, on the 10th of November follow- “ ing by the French Privateer, “ Le Brave ” “ upon which occasion George Le Feuvre the “ Master of the “ Duke of Argyll ” entered into “ an Agreement with the Captain of the said “ Privateer to ransom the said Brig for the sum “ of Six thousand livres or £250 Sterling for “ which sum the said George Le Feuvre drew a “ Bill of Exchange on his Owners payable to the
