In the name of God Amen, I Patrick Power of Lower Point Conception Bay in the Island of Newfoundland, make this my last will and Testament. I resign my soul to its Creator; in all humble hopes of its future happiness, as in the disposal of a being infinitely good, as to my body My will is, that it be buried in a Christian like Manner; I hereby make and appoint my Particular friends, William Broderick, Timothy Dinneen and Dennis Noonan, Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

- 1st I bequeath to the Rev^d Mr. Thomas Excoer twenty Pounds Sterling, to be paid at the Will of my Executors.
- 2^d I bequeath twenty Pounds to be sent to the Kingdom of Ireland, there to have Masses said according to the Custom of the place, allowing three Shillings for each Suspendium if not less than said usage - (an erasmu)
- 3^d I will that the Mills Pond, now held by Thomas & James Pearl, at five Pounds a year for a lease of twenty Years, shall become their their sole property, after my said death & mine while they or their Children remain on its premises.

that neither they or their children can dispose of it to any person, but my Nephew Thomas Power or his heirs.

4^{thly} I will that two Tomb Stones be procured as my Executors may direct, one for my Brother, the other for my own Grave, as also that the part allotted for the Church Land, be decently walled in.

5^{thly} I Bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife, the one half of my remaining property, with privilege to remain undisturbed untill she changes her Condition by Matrimony, but in such case she is to have this place, and if will be in the power of my Nephew Thomas Power to purchase her part of this fishing room and plantation, at the valuation of my Executors or any three Men by them appointed.

6^{thly} I will that my sister Joannes Sondergan, alias Power, shall have from the other half of my property, one hundred pounds, to be given to her or her heirs.

7^{thly} I will that my Nephew Thomas Power shall possess, all the part that is not disposed by these Wills and Testament, that is to say, one half of this fishing room and plantation, exclusive of Thomas & James Power's Light Room, it is also to be understood, that should Thomas and James Power relinquish or neglect the room it is to be possessed by my Nephew Thomas Power.

8^{thly} I Will that my three Nephews, John Patrick & Michael Power, shall on their leaving this place in y^e Spring, receive each a full Part of Clothed from my said Part. ~

9^{thly} I have sincerely to recommend to my Nephew Thomas Power, that as he regards me, I expect that he will pay every attention, which will not injure himself, to the Children, of his Father, and my Dear Brother. ~

10^{thly} I Will that the residue of all my property not disposed of by this Will, be equally divided between my Nephew the said Thomas Power, son of James, John & David & James, sons of David Power deceased. ~

I Will that the part allowed to John & Davids and James, Sons of Davids Power, shall devolve on my lawful Wife Mary, in lieu thereof I will that John & Davids & James Power, aforesaid shall receive one Shilling each. This is my last Will & Testament, and all other Wills and deeds are null and void.

We the undersigned being the heirs of the late Patrick Power, became bound each to the other in the sum of two Hundred Pounds £²⁰⁰ to be paid by the party failing to the party performing in the following agreement viz^t Mary Power Spouse to the late Patrick Power, and Thomas Power Nephew to said Patrick Power being the principal persons mentioned in his wills hereby agree to abide by the wills made by said P. Power on or about the seventh day of March last, which was the only will he made while in a sound state of Body & mind and by which we agree to abide under the aforesaid penalty -
