Charles Tessier married "Granny Tessier", (the old lady I mentioned coming to our house for occasional meals when we were young. She lived to be 91, with all her faculties)

(He was in the fishing business, and had a retail grocery store, and insurance).

Charlie had twin brothers, Peter and Louis who never married, as far as Mom knows. They lived with an old maid Aunt Annie in a cottage on Water Street.

Mr. Charles and Granny Tessier (we forget her first name) had these children, (not in order of ages) - Ralph, Will, Cyril, Germon, Harold, Ernest and Hilda, Ruby, Geraldine and Beatrice (who is Mrs. Wm. Herder, 86 yrs. old, and the one I was telling you that Mother visits in the General Hospital - she is nearly on the way out). The only other one alive of Charlie's family is Geraldine (a Mrs. Smith) who is living in New Brunswick.

Joan Tessier Laidlaw, (the one you wrote yesterday), is a daughter of William Tessier, son of Charles.

Mother doesn't know Charlie's father's name, but will contact a niece of his, she is now 86 yrs. old with a "fairly good memory" but failing physically. She is a Mrs. Pritchard (whose husband, I believe, was a doctor from Brigus). She lives in one of the Linden Court or Allendale apts.).

Mother says Mrs. Charles Tessier died maybe 20-25 yrs. ago. She will find out just when so you'll be able to judge when she was born. Her two brothers-in-law of course were Peter and Louis.

Charles and his big family all lived at Germondale as you know.
