RANDOM NOTES ON THE WINTER FAMILY.

February 27, 1967.

Family came from Devonshire.

John Winter of Uplime, Devon, died in 1674.  
Next George, who died in 1702.  
His son, Samuel died in 1742.  
These all lived and died in Uplime.

James W. 1757-1826 moved to Stokingtonhead. Was twice married. He came to Newfoundland as a mariner but returned to England.

James's 6th child, George was the first of the Winter ancestors to be born, live and die in Newfoundland. In 1852 in his will, George described himself as "Deputy Ordnance Store Keeper at St. John's, Newfoundland. His son, James, Grandfather was born in 1801 and died in 1884. He married Harriet Pitman of Lamaline. He was Customs Officer there. Harry Winter's father was born there in 1845.

Family started with Vice Admiral Sir George Winter of the Spanish Armada 1588. (Is this the same family?)

1750 first Winter in Newfoundland was James Winter.

Son George born 1772, largest landowner in St. John's "Georgetown" north and East of Military Road, Winter Avenue, etc.

Some of his sons moved to other parts of Newfoundland particularly south west Coast 1875? Lamaline etc.

Sir Marmaduke Winter born 1857-1936

Son R. Gordon Winter died 1950 grandsons: Gordon A. Winter  
Gerald M. Winter, M. Walcot Winter, Herbert M. Winter. *Robert G's

Hon. James Alexander Winter Q.C. Member of Commission of *Marmaduke*  
Government April 8, 1936. *son of George*

GEORGE WINTER: Served in the barrack commissariat and ordnance departments in Newfoundland for fifty years.  
Died April 6, 1859 aged 87 years.

JAMES M. WINTER, Appointed stipendiary magistrate at Harbour Briton in place of Thomas N. Gaden, 1862; died June 18, 1863, aged 55 years.

HON. J. WINTER, M.D. elected M.H.A. for Trinity district in 1855; 1859 and 1861; appointed to the Legislative Council in 1856; died May 10, 1891.
