JAMES WINTER LIVED WITH MICHAEL GILL AS A SERVANT. during the 1760s  
and new all about the transaction.  
during the 1780s he supplied wm lang(winter) HE WAS IN  
ENGLAND AT THE TIME AND HIS SON THE DEPTUY COMMISSARY OR CLERK WAS ENGAGED  
AND UNABLE TO DEAL WITH THE MATTER. WINTED WON:
