to send POMONA to england with fish/oil to bring back salt
BETSY sailing soon to touch but not load at BB
UNION is to take my sisters fish
"I flatter yourself you will be friendly to my people" and give them advice
THUS THE TWO separate . Mr Barter his agent?

1799 13 dec sup ct edith attyrs hart/eppes sued jas keating to repair premises rent fm her. he sub leased them to wm pendergast(to pay 8/10/6 for that) and mr meauslin(to pay 17/19/9 for that)

1804 may dorset admins EDITH(mother) admin estate natbrooks poole decd(capt half pay of col rogers prov corps of NY RNAGERS)

BROOKS

1804 4 def sup ct ESTATE OF EDITH.

1. Nat philips/other creditos asked to receive money fm plantations in ST JNS AND BAY BULLS.
 2. JOS BARTER of Poole demand on plants met by O IN C of 25 Jan 1797.
 3. GEO GADEN for Barter resisted this - JOS BARTER made a 2nd mortgage on estate
 4. ASSIGNEES of mrs brooks want to sell the mortgaged estates by public auction this done in 1795 by lease and release THEY SOLD TO MR ROUTH "FOR USE OF THE MORTGAGEE" plead statute of limitations under 33 geo 3(6 years) MONEY FM THIS SALE 1764/17/11 was "borrowed by mrs brooks for legal purposes" SHE AONLY POSSESSED A LIFE INTEREST IN THE ESTATE
- FACTS OF THE CASE:
1. EDITH BROOKS OF POOLE husband died in 1775 SHE CARRIED ON trade/fishery at BB
 2. 1789 2/3 mar JOS BARTER advanced her L1200 she gave him her right to two plants at Brurist Heart Hill ST JNS and one at Bay Bulls(in latter plant she joined by her CHILDREN to whom it been bequeathed by father NATHANIEL as tenants in common
 3. 1789 FISHERY CARRIED ON FOR HER BY JN CULL their agent he drew bills for L7-800 for wages/supplies etc that season.
 4. 1790 28 jan EDITH BROOKS DECLARED INSOLVENT. Jos Barter/jn Jeffery trustees
 5. 1794 28 nov NAT PHILIPS SUED ESTATE FOR 109/14/- obtained judgement fm coke
 6. BARTER now wants judgement reversed as bad law. PHILIPS DEBT was for current supplies in 1789
 7. BARTER APPEALED IN ENGLAND Master of Rolls 1796
 8. 1797 jan COURT OF APPEAL IN ENGLAND REVERSED THE DECISION. BUT liberty given to bring a fresh action.
 9. 1797 12 aug NAT PHILIPS v Jos barter new case before coke in Nfld
