The firm of Bulley and Job was one of a dozen which arose in an around the town of Teignmouth between 1770 and 1820, all owing their existence to the Newfoundland, and especially deep sea fishery on the Most of these men operated from St Johns and xheir but Grand Banks. only Bulley founded a concern which continued into the xwmxx twentieth The Bullexxfamily, together whith with almost every century. Bukkey. other family in the region had been connected with the Newfoundland fishery were generations but few er none had ever abhieved great wealth or status in the trade, especially when compared with the merchants of Poole, Topsham or Dartmouth. Their opportunity came with the end of the Seven Years War which signalled an expansion in the Newfoundland fishery which extended for thirty years and allowed many servants, ship captains, Bye Boat Keepers and Planters to Prise in the world. The men from the villages around Teignmouth chose as their weekik vehicle the Bank Fishery which expanded very rapidly after 1763. Entry was easy for the vessels were small and cheap, whilst the profit from fishing was enlarged by that which came from transporting "out and home" the horde of servants and bye boat keepers who migrated annually between xhexkeixe the British Isles and Newfoundland. Most of these firms rose with the Bank fishery and declined with it during the first half of the 19th century, but the firm of Bulley and Job, by mowingxtoxkiver estabblishing a branch (soon to become their head office) in Liverpool in 1806 managed to broaden its activities and flourish mightily, LONG AFTIR THU OTHURS IN

The early career of Samuel Bulley is uncertain, mainly because there were three "Samuel Bulley's" operating from Devonshire to Newfoundland

He probably began as an apprentice to one of between 1750 and 1780. the Devonshire bye boat keepers or ship owners, but in 1770 he obtained a vessel of his own which he commanded for five years in the Bank fishery. He was probably in partnership with the Wilking family who owned a "plantation in st Johns . The War of the American revolution must have caused great problems for Bulley since between 1775 and 1783 his name disappears both as a ship captain owner and as visitor to Newfoundland. He probably became a junior partner in the firm of Samuel Cocking and Company. with the end of the war Bulley againxentexedxenxhiexxemexxement formed a new partnership with Daniel Codner of Kingskerswell , and Elias Rendell of Combe in Teignhead. In 1788 John Job, who seems to have been brought up by Bulley after he was orphaned in 1766 and had served his apprenticeship , iminedxihexxiixmxand was sent to St Johns to manage the Newfoundland Soon after this Ne married one of Samuel Bulley's daughter\$5 end of the Trade. BY 1796 Codner and Rendell had dropped out 16 and became a partner in the Company. and the firm took on the title of Bulley and Job. Bulley's two eldest sons Thomax Samuel and Thomas were now in their teens and in 1797 Samuel Junior (under the tutelage of John Job) was sent to Newfoundland as agent, whilst 138 Thos Bulley, at the age of 18 became commander of their brig Flora 10 . In 1799 Jobxandxthextwoxboxxxwerexbothxcapturedxbxxxxxxceech the Flora with Job and the two boys onboard was taken by a French primateer on the voyage THEY RETURNED out to Newfoundland reterming to England only after an uncomfortable captivity of six months. This must have sorely tried Samuel Bulley who was left in England with no one to organise the trade in St Johns. However Despite this and other war losses the firm seems to have flourished to a modest degree and FOA whilst the Dartmouth and Poole merchants were reducting their trade under the impact of wartime losses, the firm of Bulley Job managed to steadily increased Their shipping fleet for example averaged but one vessel a year between in size. 1786-1793; but between 1798 and 1806 they operated an average of four per year.

When the Treaty of Amiens was signed in 180 Samuel Bulley could look back with relief, if not pleasure upon the survival of **thex** his business during the long war years. However times were changingthe bank fishery, seriously hit by enemy attacks and the depredations of Naval press gangs who pressed many of the most experienced seamen was decliining rapidly. ThexWestx&buntryxteexwas the West of England-Newfoundland connection was weakening as the resident population in Newfoundland increased, whilst in England the EXPANDING increasing the manufactures of industrial revolution was makx Northern and Central England at the expense of these established in the West Country. The Trade to Newfoundland was increasingly being organised from Liverpool and London rather than Dartmouth, Exeter In 1805 Samuel Bulley and his partners made a decision which or Poole. was to prove the salvation of the Company. John Job, and Bulley's youngest son William Wilking Bulley opened a branch in Liverpool. Samuel Benior probably had little to do with the decision for by now he was seriously ill. He died soon after leaving Job , and his sons with a modest fortune and a secure base for the future.
