The early career of Samuel Bulley is uncertain, mainly because there

between 1750 and 1780. He probably began as an apprentice to one of the Devonshire bye boat keepers or ship owners, but in 1770 he obtained a vessel of his own which he commanded for five years in the Bank fishery.

In 1805 Samuel Bulley and his partners made a decision which was to prove the salvation of the Company. John Job, and Bulley's youngest son William Wilking Bulley opened a branch in Liverpool. Samuel Benior probably had little to do with the decision for by now he was seriously ill.²³ He died soon after leaving Job, and his sons with a modest fortune and a secure base for the future.
