My agent at FORTEUAX capt clem Touet now in jersey. complains
my room at Admirals pt taken by capt elliot and given to
capt phil dean as unused.

in 1784 1 sent 2 ships to blanc sablon to commerce a fishery.
then bought pt of another plant in FOTEAUX BAY "Poingrestre and
Robinson which dissolved 1795 then I and THOS FALLE used till

1802 then dissolved - auction at jersey I bought for L755 1803
THEN I WAS SENDING 2 ships every year till could not get
enough men (one each to forteaux/blanc sablon) - then sent just
to forteaux.

1812 jersey men in forteaux heard us ships coming - came back
with little ifhs badly dried - great loss and abandoned the place

1813 I sent a ship to "great room and "adms pt"

BUT CAPT/w2 men lost in boat there. Mate left youngster as
agent/2 more - they cost much loss.

1814 sent ship under Touet . and in MAY AFTER PEACE at great
cost bought ship/crew and sent after - she misse the season.

At same time Dean and partners got elliot to grant the room
they now offer it for sale.
