1762 lester diary. "and Reeves". had stage at Trinity South Side. burnt by  
orders of French.

1762 17 feb trinity reg and reeve their svt thos pendergast buried

DEVONSHIRE

1766 19 jul farley journal MR CHRIS died money in house on castle ditch  
a very eminent and wealthy y mcht and one of those people called  
quakers. carried to minhead in devonshire for burial with ancestors

DEVONSHIRE

1814 20 oct trinity ct and reeves- a room in old perlican still  
called "devonshire and reeves room"
