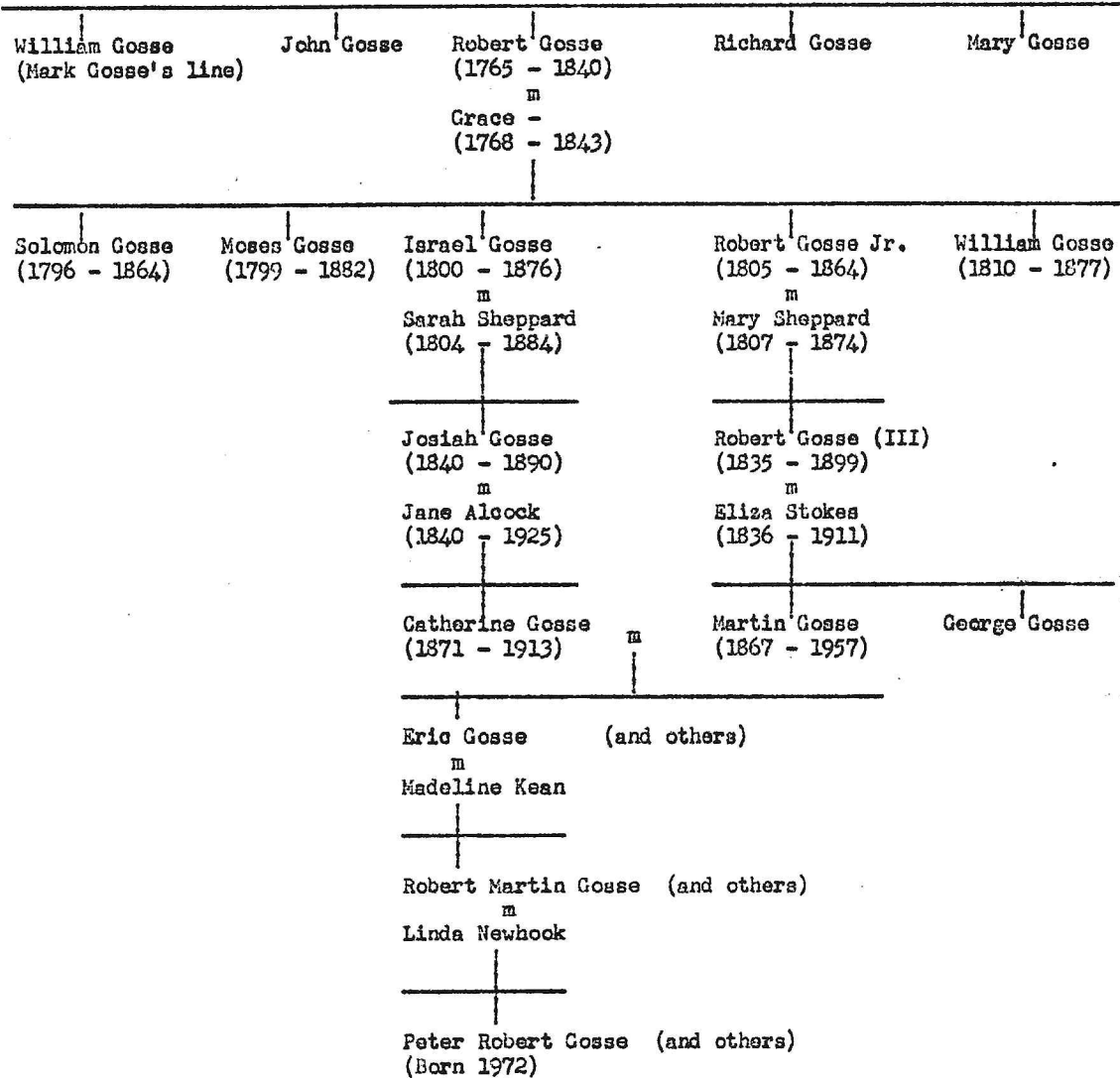

* Vincent Elliot was born and raised in Vancouver, B.C. His mother is a Gosse from Spaniard's Bay and in 1946 he did exhaustive research on church records at Harbour Grace, Bishop's Cove and Spaniard's Bay. From these sources and the memories of the oldest inhabitants he compiled genealogies for some of the main branches of the Gosse family.

Dear Mr. Smallwood,

I refer to our recent conversation in which you expressed some interest in the nineteenth century shipbuilding record of the Gosse family of Spaniard's Bay.

In this connection I am enclosing: (1) A brief outline of the family tree to avoid any confusion in the names of relatives. (2) A detailed compilation of vessels built, not only by the Gosses, but also by the forebears of other Spaniard's Bay families, which I copied from the British Colonial Registry of Shipping. The list also includes three outsiders, including the famous Michael Kearney and John Symne of St. John's and William Hunt, probably from Harbour Grace. It is quite likely that all three built at Spaniard's Bay to take advantage of the local shipwright skills, the availability of suitable timber and the adequate supplies of iron, rigging and sailcloth readily available from the firm of Wm. Donnelly.

There are presently no shipping registrations from 1853 to 1860 and from 1889 to 1900. but Dr. Matthews, the Nfld. Maritime Historian for Memorial University, informs me that these should be available before 1977.

Between 1804 and his retirement in 1831 Robert Gosse Sr. built 11 schooners and 1 brig, ranging in size from 45 tons to 116 tons. His reputation as a skilled and efficient builder was well known in Conception Bay; consequently he was successful in obtaining vessel construction contracts from business establishments or private parties, not only in Spaniard's Bay but in Harbour Grace, Bay Roberts, Barenhead and Brigus. From 1817 to 1831 he built 8 vessels, each averaging 80 tons, so that the construction rate was 1 craft in less than two years. I must deduce from this evidence that he and his sons were full time professional ship builders during these years and fishing had been reduced to a sideline. This conclusion is strengthened when one takes into account that harsh weather and hand tools were factors bound to slow the speed of construction.

No sooner had Robert Sr. laid down his tools when his second son, Moses obtained a contract to construct a 69 ton schooner for Wm. Richards at Barened called the "Favourite" and completed in 1832.

In 1833 Moses and his brother Israel built the "Orestes", a 78 ton schooner as co-partners to prosecute the seal fishery.

Not to be outdone, Robert Sr.'s fourth son, Robert Jr. obtained a contract from Alfred Mayne, merchant of Harbour Grace; Wm. Fryer, banker, and John Gosse, merchant, both hailing from Dorset, England, to build the "Ann" a 123 ton brig. She was completed at Harbour Grace in 1834.

Three years were to elapse before Robert Gosse Jr. obtained another contract to build the 100 ton brig "Melina" at Spaniard's Bay for Joseph Soper, merchant at Harbour Grace. She was launched and commissioned in 1838. During this period he obviously went back to fishing and probably sailed to the seal fishery with his brothers in the "Orestes".

During the 1840's Solomon Gosse, the eldest son of Robert Sr. also built 3 small schooners on contract. This was a period in which 4 of his 5 sons were independently pursuing the vessel construction business. The greatest feat, however, was by his third son, Israel, who in 1843 built and owned outright the "Pomona", a 127 ton brig, flaunting a female bust as a figurehead. He and Moses outfitted her and the "Orestes" for the seal fishery that spring but there is no record of how they fared financially.

In 1861 Robert Jr. built the "Victoria", a 42 ton schooner of which he was owner and captain but by now ship building was only a secondary occupation, while the codfishery had become the major source of livelihood.

He died prematurely in 1864, and his wife immediately took over the "Victoria", sailed with her six sons to St. John's in the spring, took on board fishery supplies and successfully prosecuted the Labrador fishery.

She appointed her second son "young" Robert as master of the "Victoria", probably because in her view, he was the best educated and most promising of all her boys. For a few years they operated under her guidance but by 1869 young Robert or Captain Robert as he was now called sold his shares in the family interests and built a home in Green Head on two acres of land which is still in the possession of his grandchildren.

While he continued to build schooners on contract when opportunity offered, his main efforts were directed towards the Labrador fishery and the seal hunt. His career in both endeavours was so successful that in 1886 he set up the firm of G. & M. Gosse for his sons, which continued to prosper in the salt fish business until their retirement in 1949.

Captain Robert was forced through bad health to relinquish command of the "S. S. Vanguard" in 1895 and died four years later.

Between 1804 and 1878 the Gosse family of Spaniard's Bay built 29 schooners and 4 brigs. Their shipbuilding skills were carried on into the 20th century as my father built a 25 ton schooner on contract, while my uncle made her suit of sails and rigged her. Father afterwards sailed her to the Labrador where she was taken over by the owner.

In addition, these co-partners, operating in business under the name of G. & M. Gosse, rebuilt two 90 ton schooners during the 1920's. It is interesting to note that the sons and grandsons of other Spaniard's Bay builders shown in the attached list were shipwrights on both these projects.

As I recall the last two vessels built in Spaniard's Bay were constructed by Abraham Sheppard in 1929 and Lemuel Barrett in 1944. Both were powered by gasoline motors.

I intend to complete the records of vessel construction by Spaniard's Bay shipwrights for the 19th century when this material becomes available. Indications are that between 1882 and 1900 Mark Gosse Sr., founder of Mark Gosse & Sons Ltd. was the leading ship builder of this period. His ability as a millwright, carpenter and business man is well known but I know from information gathered from some of his contemporaries that in vessel construction he showed outstanding talents.

Finally, I must mention that my brother, Roy, who was in the Royal Navy during the First World War, joined the Royal Canadian Navy in 1940 as a leading seaman. A friend of his was struggling with the building instruction manual required to qualify as a shipwright. Roy took on the job of tutor, since he was well trained in boat construction by father, and wrote the examination with his pupil. They were both successful and in due course promoted to Chief Petty Officer Shipwrights.

I think this just about covers the subject and perhaps in too much detail.
