

Admeasurement of a Piece of Ground
taken possession of as a void, & lot on the 22nd
day of November, 1824, by Martin Swainy, for
the purpose of carrying on the Fishery, situated
at English Harbor, being one half of a Fishing
room formerly known by the name of Croucher's
room, but occupied for many years past by
William Jones Senior, if cutting grass upon it
can be called occupation, he having purchased
it in the year 1803 from Mr. Saml. Pollis
Merchant of Poole.

This room measures along the land
wash from East to West 112 yards.
