AGREED TO WAIT UNTIL NOV 1814

LITTLE

1817 15 sep sup ct graham appealed in case agst trustees of dooling/kelly. he had agreed with them to have his house from Feb 1816. they withheld the agreement.

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1817 18 sep sup ct appeal v trustees dooling and kelly for L500 1 years rent of house rented by him to dooling/kelly for 71 years in 1815. they insolvent in 1816 but trustees kept possession til 1 may 1816 to dispose of effects - vacated the premises but have not paid rent fm 1 nov 1815. awarded L250 as decided by lower court.

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1817 17 oct sup ct GRAHAM sued trustees dooling/kelly. HE RETIRED AND SOLD HIS STOCK TO THEM for L5310 secured by a mortgage on leasehold premises dated 4 may 1814 to be paid in 3 annual instalments of 1710/-/- due ~~at~~ 1 may 1815/16/17 they became insolvent after first instalment due. TRUSTEES had paid out dividend of 10/-d in L he to get his share
