The rate was 2/6 [British pounds] per qtl of fish and 20/-d [British pounds] per ton of oil. Pippy only brought home 160 qtls of fish and 3 casks of oil. 320 casks of oil had been expected.

Duggan/Pippy ? won even though less fish than expected.
