

THE SNIKKRINK CAREER OF THOMAS ROE SENIOR/Junior.

1801. Commanded the Hawk 190 (or 150) tons 14 men and 2 guns.  
Owned by Spurrier and Company of Poole/.  
March Voyage Poole- Liverpool and Newfoundland.  
November new of arrival at Boston(Mass) from Newfoundland.
- 1802 Commanded the NANCY ship 250 tons(or 219) 14 men owned Spurrier of Poole  
July News of her arrival at New York fm Newfoundland.
- 1803 3 April arrived a Gibraltar from Trepani in Sicily(with salt)  
July new of arrival at Newfoundland from Trepani  
July news of arrival at New york from Newfoundland.  
16 October. Arrived Poole from Newfoundland.
- 1804 March. Poole - Newfoundland(crew 9 m,en)but had to await convoy  
22 June. Portsmouth-Newfoundland under ~~v~~onvoy.  
September news of her arrival at Newfoundland.  
29 October. Arrived Lisbon from Newfoundland.
- 1805 16feb news of arrival at Lisbon badly damaged in a storm at Lisbon.  
March Poole to newfoundlnad with 40ø Passengers for the fishery  
September at Burin in Newfoundland. sailed to Poole  
22 December arrived Poole from Newfoundland.
- 1806 February, with 76 passengers sails to Newfoundland from Poole/waterford  
July news of arrival at Newfoundland from Waterford  
November news of arrival at Boston from Newfoundland.
- 1807 16 January arrived Poole from Newfoundland  
March sails from Liverpool-0Newfoundland  
14 October arrived at Boston from Newfoundland
- 180-8 6 April arrived Liverpool from Newfoundland and Falmouth  
May(No passengers) designed for a voyage to Portugal but sails  
to Newfoundland instead.  
September news of arrival at Newfoundland from Liverpool  
2 October arrived Poole from Newfoundland  
October sails Poole-Portugal.  
27 November news of arrival at gibraltar from Poole.
- 1809 23 February arrived Malaga from Poole  
17 April Arrived Stansgate Creek from Malaga  
June sailed from Poole-Cadiz.
- 1810 February Pool-nfldl  
Returned from Newfoundland and was then appointed to command  
Spurrier's Emulation a ship of ~~220~~ tons with a crew ranging from  
10-14 men. 194  
August at Bideford(Devon) sailed to Newfoundland.
- 1811 22 April arrived at Lisbon from Newfoundland.
- 1812 17 Febrary arrived Cadiz from Newfoundland  
1 April Arrived Gibraltar from Cadiz  
29 April arrived at Alicante. from Gibraltar  
June news of her arrival at alicant frolm Cadiz  
6 October arrived Lisbon from Newfoundland  
1q7 October arrived Alicante from Lisbon.
- 1813 10 february arrived Dubl|in from Alicante.  
26 April sailed from Cork-Newfoundland in Convoy with 90 passengers.  
July news of arrival at Newfoundland.  
September news of arrival at St Andero(Santander) from Newfoundland  
27 September arrived Newfoundland from Corunna(Spain)

- 1814 appointed to command Spurrier's UPTON 260 tons 14-15 man crew.  
 March Poole, at Waterford to Newfoundland with 90- passengers.  
 OCTOBER in England appoin-ed to command Spurrier's HANNAH  
 268 tons 14 man crew.  
 26 October Portsmouth- Ireland and Newfoundland in convoy.  
 2 November sailed from Cork-Newfoundland/
- 1815 January news of arrival at Newfoundland  
 June Poole-Newfoundland.  
 30 November news that whilst sailing from Leghorn to Newfoundland  
 she was damaged and put into Lisbon.
- 1816 May news of arrival at Newfoundland from Lisbon.  
 (NOTE THE REFERENCE TO THIS VESSEL BEING OWNED BY JOLLIFFE , is  
 misleading - Peter Jolliffe was in fact a partner in the firm of  
 Spurriers and Company.
- 1817 September ~~XXXXNewfoundland~~ appointed to command Spurriers VENUS  
 a 287 ton ship.  
 October sailed from Poole to Newfoundland
- 1818 appointed to command the COLUMBIA owned Spurriers. 149 tons  
 10 man crew.  
 September Poole-Newfoundland
- 1819 7 January arrived off Poole from Newfoundland with storm damage.  
 March sailed Poole-Newfoundland.  
 19 July at Burin was sued by John Kirby, boats master to a planter  
 Geo Moulton for assault . he was fined 60/-d and bound over to keep  
 the peace.  
 19 October arrived Oporto from Newfoundland.
- 1820 ~~XXXXPooleNewfoundland~~.  
 2 February arrived Poole from Newfoundland in 22 days.  
 March sailed from Poole-Newfoundland.  
 17 October arrived at Cadiz from Newfoundland.  
 1 December sailed from cadiz to Poole with salt
- 1821 April sailed Poole-Newfoundland.
- 1822 May sailed Poole-Newfoundland  
 20 December arrived at Palermo from Newfoundland.
- 1823 21 March arrived Stangate creek from Palermo.  
 28 July arrived stangate creek from ~~Almeria~~ Almeria  
 26 September arrived at Newfoundland from London
- 1824 10 March at St Johns Newfoundland sailed to Oporto with 2970 quintals  
 of fish.
- 1825 19 April arrived at Gravesend from Oporto  
 August sailed from Bristol to Newfoundland.

- 18275 appointed to command the SYREN, owned Slade, Harrison and Company  
 of Poole and Carbonear.  
 14 July arrived Poole from Newfoujndland.  
 20 November arrived Poole from Newfoundland
- 1828 27 October arrived at Carbonear Newfoundland from Liverpool  
 4 December sailed to Poole with 4300 quintals of fish
- 1829 25 July arrived at Carbonear from Trepani with salt  
 24 October. sailed from Carbonear for a market with 4300 quintals fish  
 26 December arrived at Poole from Newfoundland
- 1830 12 July arrived at Carbonear from Liverpool  
 6 August sailed Carbonear- Poole with ~~xxxx~~ train oil and seal skins  
 6 December sailed from Carbonear to Poole  
 31 December arrived at Poole from Newfoundland

- 1831 21 April arrived at Carbonear from Poole and Waterford
- 28 May sailed to Poole with seal oil and skins
- 25 August arrived at Carbonear from Poole and Bilbao
- 28 December sailed Carbonear- Poole with 4100 quintals fish
- 1832 25 June arrived Carbonear from Lisbon and Bilbao.

- 1827 commanded the MERCURY 160 tons 9 men of Poole
- 27 November arrived at St Johns from Poole
- 1828 commander of the RUBY 135 tons 8 men of Poole
- 26 December arrived at Poole from Newfoundland with storm damage
- ~~1828xxxxxJulyxxxxxx arrived at St Johns from Liverpool~~
- 1829 appointed to command the MERCURY of Poole owned Slade/Harrison/co 178 tons
- ~~26 August~~ July arrived at St Johns from Liverpool
- 26 August sailed from Carbonear to Poole
- 19 November arrived Carbonear from Poole
- 28 December sailed from Carbonear to Poole with a cargo which included seal skins.
- 1830 ~~January~~ October arrived St Johns from Leghorn. with biscuit and flour
- 1831 Sailed from Poole to Quebec.
