1. GEORGE STONE

i. OF BELL ISLAND

1772 Married Mary Hacket of Portugal Cove (she was probably an Irish Girl and a Catholic). No more known of him.

2. DEVONSHIRE

George buried at Topsham in 1787

George a tradesman in Ashburton in 1780.

George Hairdresser of Brixham, with Nich Andrews (Mariner) owned in 1814-15 the ELIZABETH sloop 39 tons. sold her in 1816

George (Teignmouth) 1830 commander of the ABEONA a teignmouth merchant ship at St Johns Newfoundland.

None of the birth places of these men have as yet been discovered

3. POOLE

1788 Geo and wife Elizabeth (who were both born/married somewhere other than Poole) had son John (Anglican).

1796 had son James

1791 had son William

1799 HE DIED.

(another George)

1799 Born the son of William and Mary Stone

All of these were anglican.

STONE JONAS

(a) 1753 Commander of the ELIZABETH 40 tons 6 men of topsham voyage to Newfoundland for Messrs Follett who were merchants at ~~TREPSSAY~~ TREPASSEY. (December returned to Exeter from Newfoundland and Gijon with a cargo of nuts for the Folletts'.

(b) 1760 He had become at BOAT KEEPER AT TREPSSAY and was in debt to the trustees of Smith and Applebee, Teignmouth merchants insolvents.

(c) 1821 JONAS of Tipperary married in St Johns Catholic Church Joanna Cashin of St Johns.
