

Memorandum of an agreement between John Bland High Sheriff, of Newfoundland, on the part of Sarah Street of London, and William Collins of Trinity in Newfoundland.

John Bland agrees, to let unto William Collins, for the term of Thirty Years from the 30th of October next ensuing, all that room in the S. W. Arm of Trinity, commonly known by the name of Cowin Room, now in the occupation of Madam Lord Nelson for and in consideration of the sum of Four pounds. annual rent, to be paid on the 30th of October in each year — In testimony whereof, I have, on the part of Sarah Street, set my hand to this Memorandum, on the tenth day of September, in the Year One thousand, Eight hundred, and twenty two.
