Following information is in our files:

1. HUGH, son of Hugh and Mary baptised Poole August, 1779.
2. 1796 November age 19 at St. Lawrence, Newfoundland joined the crew of the SYREN of Dartmouth owned by Robert Newman and Company. Discharged at Dartmouth in March, 1797.  
1797 April - joined the same vessel for a voyage to Newfoundland and Southern Europe. Discharged January, 1798.  
1799 married at St. Saviour's Church, Dartmouth, Mary Pearce.
3. THOMAS of Kingsbridge, Devon, married in 1800 Phillippa Lamb in Ashburton Church.
4. MILES (1) of Poole died in Poole age 30 in 1813.
5. MILES (11) of Poole married at Trinity, Newfoundland in 1836, Rose Bugden of Trinity. He was probably a seaman on a vessel owned by Messrs. Slade and Kelson of Poole.
6. CHRISTIAN NAME Unknown - Shipmaster.
  - (a) 1816 commander of the Inegrity owned Fisher and Co. 5th March Waterford from Weymouth in ballast, 25th August Waterford from Exeter with Pipe Clay.
  - (b) 1818 commander of the PROSPERITY, owned Charles Buck. 19th November Graves from Jersey. 1820 January 28th, Gravesend from Jersey 10th October Gravesend from Jersey

1821 commander of the DORCHESTER schooner 83 tons 9 men built Topsham, in 1811.  
Owned by Loader and Company (of Weymouth ?) in the London-Waterford trade. (and himself part-owner).

1822 commander of the UNION sloop 57 tons 8 men built at Dover in 1810. Voyage from Dartmouth-Newport and owned by himself.

1825 9th November whilst going from London-Topsham ran ashore at Weymouth, but was later refloated.
