WESTON William.

It is not easy to separate this Williams with another William of Poole who is also trading to Newfoundland during the first forty years of the 18th century. In fact I would not be at all suprised to find they are in some cases one and the same man. This possibility arises because of the paucity of information mentioning ~~of~~ William of WEYMOUTH in the ENGLISH shipping and customs records, while he is mentioned quite frequently at the Newfoundland end. We know he was a ship captain, and we have more or less complete details of all the shipping which traded to Newfoundland at this time. Yet never once is there a mention of a William commanding a WEYMOUTH ship. There are many references to William(s) commanding POOLE ships.

1. Given the fact that his property in St Johns certainly descended to a BENJAMIN said to have been of POOLE, then this ~~hypothesis~~ hypothesis is strengthened.
2. Time and expense prevent me from going into details of the ships and voyages commanded by the @Poole@ Captain William.
3. Your William is certainly a man of some importance At St Johns by 1729 because he was one of the first Justices of the Peace to be appointed following an Order In Council issued in that year. However he was not normally resident in the town - like the other merchants he tended to commute annually between Dorset and Newfoundland, although he might stay for the occasional winter.
- 3.4 He is not only a Captain- commanding his own fishing vessel; he is also a merchant, involved in supplying the local fishermen with goods in return for fish.
- 4.5 By 1736 his business interests obviously extended to Ferryland on the Southern Shore of Newfoundland and note BELOW PETER, who eventually inherited some of his property and who was ~~late~~ Justice of the Peace in that community.

BENJAMIN. PETER

Appears to have taken over Westons Property is not his extensive trading interests in St Johns.

1. First appears in 1731 as the commander of a BRISTOL vessel trading to St Johns and is a "constant trader" to Newfoundland during the 1730s and 1740s.
2. in circa 1750 settles in Newfoundland as a merchant and Factor at Ferryland. In 1754 is appointed Justice of the Peace, and re-appointed annually until 1772.
3. by 1776 he is dead and his Widdow Catherine takes over the Business which includes owning a vessel trading between Bristol and St Johns almost certainly a she had two daughters CATHERINE and SARAH HE IS A RELATIVE OF BENJAMIN of Bristol who might thus be the SON of William whom you mentioned.

- . Benjamin first appears only after he is already dead (unless he is a Benjamin of Poole). In 1740 his Widow Sarah obtained confirmation of ownership to his property in St Johns, most of which was now leased out to others.
2. in 1770 SARAH died and the land passed to HER daughter Elizabeth of Bristol.
3. Elizabeth is still alive in 1812 and attempts to regain possession of the land. but it is by now hopelessly alienated and the connection with Newfoundland ceased.

Brief footnotes on the family tree of William Weston which you enclosed:-

1. MARY who married John Ludwig. John Ludwig was a Planter in ~~St. John's~~ Ferryland ~~and Ferryland~~ during the 1730s and 40s. He too was a Justice of the Peace at times.
2. PETER WESTON commanded ships with the names of "Sarah" -which occurs in your tree, ~~and~~ (she married to BENJAMIN Weston) and "Elizabeth" which is the name of Sarah's daughter.
3. Note how both Peter Weston and Sarah Weston live at Ferryland.
4. Note William's Wife connection with Bristol which from the 1730s onwards is where the trade of all of ~~them~~ the men seem to centre.
5. ~~If~~ ^{bristol} If the Weston Family did transfer their residence from Weymouth (or Poole) to ~~Dorset~~ they would not have been unique. two or three other prominent Poole merchants did the same thing between 1730 and 1760.

WILLIAM's sons - HENRY, William and John did not play any part in the Newfoundland trade UNLESS they ~~are~~ were trading out of Poole, where all three names can be found during the first 60 years of the 18th century.
