Occupations of Roberts; Seamen, Ropemakers, Vicars, Master Mariners, Husbanmen and Brewers.

IN Newfoundland 1837 Robert of Littlehempton married in Trinity Bay Elizabeth Groves. 1866 at St Johns Robert H of Dartmouth married Susan the daughter of John Frampton, shipwright.

Notes on these Joseph's. One of them was at Ferryland Newfoundland in 1804. Another in 1708 was a Planter at St Johns Newfoundland. In 1794 JOSEPH AND COMPANY WERE BOAT KEEPERS AT ST JOHNS,- HAD BEEN involved in the Newfoundland trade since 1764- was connected with the firm of Messrs FOX AND COMPANY of Teignmouth. He was said to be "single" in Newfoundland but had a son with him in 1841 A MR (Probably Joseph) owned a fishery at round island , Sandwich Bay, Labrador. his agent there was a Mr Goodridge of paington. (in 1831 Joseph Wills was said to be a small trader at Long Island, near Grady Harbour Labrador.

1803 Joseph of Torquay was a seaman on the "Swan" of Teignmouth a Newfoundland fishing vessel. (in 1792 he was said to be from Cockington and was a seaman on the "industry".

1803-13 JOSEPH OF TEIGNMOUTH (SERVICED ON SEVERAL Teignmouth-Newfoundland Traders.

1830-1834 JOSEPH WAS COMMANDER of the SUSAN OF TEIGNMOUTH AND DARTMOUTH- by 1842 he OWNED HER. SHE WAS EMPLOYED IN THE NEWFOUNDLAND.LABRADOR TRADE. THIS WAS PROBABLY your ancestor. (almost certainly the same man who was a trader on the Labrador coast. All these Josephs were probably of the same family.
