trucks. 17th Fine Brown not to work not feeling good.
17th Fine & warm. cleaned out my water barrel
brought four tiers of water. Jim & Lizzy here in night
18th raining all day. 19th Fine all day.

November 1929

- Nov 3rd Fine day. Guy & went to church on night.
- 4th Claude Freake died in St. Johns.
Started house-cleaning.
- 5th raining. to meet for Bon-fires
- 6th Fine. Guy & I went up to Eric's. Grand
Bonfire. wind about 1/2. cleaned kitchen
- 7th cleaned Hall up-stairs mother & Ann
was here in afternoon. puppus came.
brought. Claude Freake's body. buried
him right away eye specialist came.
- 8th Fine. Guy went up to see Tom Sudlow
in night. Home came. pad Miller came
in with his fish.
- 9th ~~Snowing~~ Snowing. Edna went down in her house.
- 10th Thanksgiving day. ground covered with snow.
Guy to church twice. Edna & Cyril here in
night. a little while.
- 11th Fine all day. ~~too~~ big frost in night.
Mother & Eric were here in night. ^{Amey} steamer here
- 12th raining showers all day. Edna. mother and
me.

- 13th S.S. Lerne went out - about 5. p.m.
- 14th Fine day George took her to dinner. about half off us gave Edna a surprise party had a great time.
- 15th parking blyde came Longo Delaney came from the hospital by her. was down to Edna's. helped her to clean up.
- 16th blowing hard all day Edna came up in afternoon, Brown came in stayed, & had tea. went home about 9. o'clock.
- 17th blowing hard I went to church in morning. was up to mother's tea. Lile was here. Jimmie & Steward came in after church. not blowing quite as hard.
- 18th blowing a nice breeze. had some kind of an eruption. made ^{caused a} everything shake. lot of damage done on the South coast. 28 lives lost mostly women & children. Collin's Schooner done off. S.S. Lerne picked her up 400 miles off St Johns. one off the crew had

- 24th Ben Wake & Mr Russell went to Suellingar
by Clyde. snowing after tea wind N.E.
had a quarter of beef.
- 25th rough weather in morning. cleared
little finer afternoon. Lynn & Edna, Claude
& Beat were in here had game of cards
- 26th fine all day. 27th fine went down to
Ednas in night. butcher till came in.
& a crowd of mummies.
- 28th fine was up to mother in night. Home came
went to change sleds & harness neck
- 29th Home came back. I was to church in
morning. Miss Shppard came from C. Donthome
- 30th fine day 31st fine had a dance over to
Gas Haus 14 of us came home 2 o'clock
beautiful morning. not a bit cold.
