 11<sup>th</sup> all the ice gone out.
- April  
 Some seals got.
- Mar 15 S.S. Viking blowed up off Horse Islands  
 27 off her crew supposed to be dead, while  
 13 were injured & had to go to the Hospital.
- 19 Ansell. 2nd Sir William was lost, her crew of  
 28 men were saved.
- 30 four men were down off in the ice. but got in  
 back cone U. K. Fogla was gang out. but they got out.
- April  
 4 Myls Samuel died. S.S. Laguna ran ashore near Mrs. Hor  
 5 Fine day was to 7 o'clock sunrise. & into Edna's to breakfast  
 9<sup>th</sup> Edna moved down to Mrs. Vakis house  
 10<sup>th</sup> Fine day weather was out to Edna's. 11<sup>th</sup> ~~not~~ came.
